
## **General Update**

- 50,000+ cases globally (7,700 on Jan 30<sup>th</sup> last webinar -15 days)
  - Vast majority cases in China
- Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)
- Surpassed death toll of SARS in 2003 (910 deaths)
- Regional Disruption
- New Virus = SARS-CoV-2
- New Disease = COVID-19





Johns Hopkins Case Data Collated Through Feb 13, 2020


## How much confidence do you have in health officials' ability to educate the public on avoiding or treating COVID-19?

#### Do you think the situation will get better or worse in the next week?









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### **SECURITY ASPECTS**

- Travel disruption and restrictions;
- Adherence to local directives;
- Point-of-entry screening;
- Activating / updating Business Continuity Plans with clear escalation triggers;
- Accommodating quarantines; remote work options;
- Cancellation of travel / events, more virtual meetings;
- Closely monitoring the situation;
- Communicating to/with your workforce.
