



Pandemic Scenario

It is expected every location will have an outbreak at some stage





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

Asia

China – mainland : No new locally-acquired cases several days, but still 1,700 in serious condition.

39 imported cases - Beijing / Shanghai / Fujian, Guangdong, Shandong, Gansu, Zhejiang, Henan, Chongqing

Hong Kong / Macao / Taiwan : Majority of new cases imported

Singapore: apparent steep rise in new cases but majority imported




Malaysia: > 1,500 cases. Many are linked to mass gathering at mosque in KL end Feb.

Indonesia: cases confirmed in 20 provinces. Local transmission in Jakarta (and other areas) 8% mortality

Philippines: > 380 cases steep rise since 1st week March
